OLS at Bellevue College is an innovative 90 credit associate degree unlike any program in the nation. This program gives adults with cognitive disabilities the opportunity to acquire an accredited college degree that leads to post-graduation employment rates well above the national average. OLS students complete 43 courses in occupational and life skills. During these courses, OLS students create a career pathway over a 3 year period that is specific to their skills, strengths, and passions. What is different about OLS?

- Infused instruction including critical thinking, Social Thinking, and self-determination.
- Small class sizes and courses taught by instructors utilizing universal design and specialized instruction.

- Students build a social and employment network.
