Perspective OLS student characteristics:

- Self-motivated
- Exhibits drive to obtain a college education
- Independent with transportation
- Transitioning from class to class or activity to activity independently
- Participation in activities and conversations
- Technology savvy including MS Word, internet and e-mail use
- Capacity to critically think and problem solve
- Communicates personal knowledge and personal opinion
- Reliable with appointments and completion of assignments
- Work or volunteer experience
- May have attended college classes, but did not succeed in the traditional classroom
- Difficulty with soft skills in everyday life
- Ability to monitor and adjust actions to be suitable in varying environments
- Collaborate effectively with a group of people
